## **7. Review and Discuss Statewide Needs Assessment**

- A Needs Assessment will be used to collect data from Wisconsinites to better understand what they believe is necessary for the IL Movement across the state and in their communities.
  - The previous needs assessment was too long and somewhat difficult to complete.
  - Most of the respondents to the previous assessment were service providers, which is not the intended audience.
- The previous assessment may provide a good framework for the assessment that will be used for 2028-2030 SPIL development.
  - With additional time, translation into multiple languages should be considered.
  - The survey should be shorter and more readable.
  - The committee should explore ways to ensure that most of the respondents are not service providers.
  - ILCW SPIL Committee members will review the 2025-2027 SPIL Needs Assessment before the March, 17, 2026 ILCW SPIL Committee Meeting. See Action Item 3.
